Technology Upgrade Notification

Effective January 12, 2017, the Arizona Controlled Substances Prescription Monitoring Program (AZ CSPMP) will be upgrading to a new software to support prescription monitoring services for Arizona. We will be moving to the Appriss [PMP AWA Rx E](#) software. Beginning January 12, 2017 all prescription dispensations must be reported through the PMP Clearinghouse.

How to Register for a New Account With the PMP Clearinghouse:

- Navigate to <https://pmpclearinghouse.net>
- Click on "Create an Account"
- Fill out the registration form and select Arizona as the state you will be submitting data to

If you already have a PMP Clearinghouse Account for Another State:

- Log into the PMP Clearinghouse (<https://pmpclearinghouse.net>)
- Navigate to Account à Multi State Approval
- Select Arizona from the list of states

A request will be sent to the PMP Administrator of each selected state(s) for approval. The PMP Administrators will begin approving data submission accounts on January 12, 2017.

A new dispensation guide will be sent in a later communication.

Effective January 12, 2017, you must begin reporting to the new system. The last day you will be able to send data to existing software is January 11, 2017.
